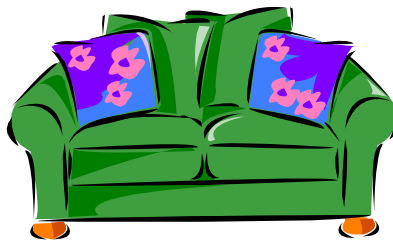

What is re:CREATE?

re:CREATE is an environmental reuse program. Reuse means using items again for the same purpose or a new one, instead of throwing them away. Reusing diverts usable materials from landfills, conserves natural resources, and saves money on disposal and supply costs. Don't throw it away or buy it new - you can re:CREATE it!
